# General overview



#### FlowOx<sup>TM</sup>

FlowOx<sup>™</sup> is a novel medical device for the treatment of peripheral arterial disease (PAD) related problems such as pain, reduced walking distance and chronic ulcers.

The use of FlowOx™ is comfortable and easy: the system generates an intermittent negative pressure (INP) that stimulates the blood circulation in the lower legs and feet, thus improving the blood flow and oxygen supply.

## FlowOx<sup>™</sup> advantages

- Non-invasive, safe and easy to use
- Suitable for home use
- Can be used in addition to surgical intervention or where surgery is contraindicated
- May be used on limbs with existing wounds if they are bandaged

### FlowOx<sup>™</sup> patient target group

- Peripheral arterial disease (PAD),
- Diabetic and non-diabetic arteriopathic foot and leg ulcers,
- Intermittent claudication and rest pain,
- Foot and lower leg ulcers of mixed aetiology associated with immobility such as paraplegia following spinal injury.



## FlowOx<sup>TM</sup> usage

For an optimal therapeutic effect, it is recommended using the device for 2 hours per day, which can be easily integrated into everyday life (e.g., one hour in the morning and one hour in the evening).

If FlowOx™ is used as recommended, patients can expect a reduction in pain and possibly visual improvements in the wound healing within 2-3 weeks.

In addition, most patients show positive long-term effects, e.g., lasting pain reduction, increased walking distance, improved blood flow and potentially complete wound healing.

In order to ensure compliance to the therapy, it is important to adapt the use of  $FlowOx^{\mathsf{TM}}$  to the patient's daily routine.
